



Warning Signs During Pregnancy

Call your provider if any of these occur:

- Sudden weight gain or loss
- Blurred vision
- Severe headache not relieved by Tylenol
- Swelling or puffiness in hands or face
- Dizziness or fainting spells
- Fever of 100.4 or higher
- Persistent rash
- Vaginal bleeding or spotting, not after sex
- Pain or burning when urinating or decreased amount of urine
- Regular, noticeable tightening in your back or stomach
- Sharp stomach pain or cramping with nausea
- Unexplained feeling that “something is wrong”
- If you think that your water has broken, go to the hospital
- Decreased movement of baby in any 12 hour period, especially in the evening or when you are resting
